Minutes of the Regularly Scheduled Board Meeting

El Monte High School, El Monte, California

September 7, 2010

Board Members present: President Henry Torres, Vice President Freddie Landinguin, Secretary-Treasurer Darren Winkley, Ernie Dominguez, Mickey Edwards, Jeff Klein

The President called the meeting to order at 5:36 PM.

Approval of Minutes

Motion to approve the minutes by Mr. Edwards; second by Mr. Landinguin. The motion passed 5-0-0.

Secretary-Treasurer Report

The secretary-treasurer reported that Temple City, Muir, and San Gabriel had all donated \$75 for scrimmages. As of today, about 35 officials have not provided proof of insurance. The president stated that we need to do something about the uninsured officials. It was decided that those officials who have not shown proof of insurance will be subject to having their games pulled.

Assignor Report

Assignments

Mr. McQueen reported that we had 19 zero-week games. He stated that referees need to fill out game reports on Arbiter after each game in addition to their ratings reports. We have four or five observers right now, and he will be asking some referees to observe when they are not working.

Committee Reports

Ratings

Mr. Landinguin reported that the ratings form is up and running. Ratings should be completed within seven days of the game being rated. Mr. Winkley stated that he would create a spreadsheet into which the data would be entered. He suggested that the committee members each be responsible for entering data for equal portions of the membership, and that he would then consolidate the data into one file at the end of the season. Each member will get a summative evaluation at the end of the year, and officials who request their evaluations during the season will be provided with anonymized versions, i.e. game information such as date, reviewer, location, and teams will be removed.

New Business

CFOA/NASO

The president reported that at the executive council meeting on August 1, 2010, the CFOA voted to enter into an agreement with NASO starting with the 2011 season. Dues may have to increase, but all materials will be provided, including insurance for the membership and for the board, Arbiter, rulebooks, etc.

Playoffs

The president reported that, as per the assignor's agreement, the assignor creates the playoff list and presents it to the board. Mr. McQueen agreed to have the board assist with the list.

Member Issues

Mr. Delbis approached the board and wanted to know why he only got one varsity game this year when he had seven last year and ten in previous years. Mr. McQueen responded that he needed to assign the best officials to the games and that Mr. Delbis's appearance led to a lack of credibility. Mr. Winkley added that it was not an issue of weight, but rather grooming.

Motion to adjourn by Mr. Dominguez. The meeting adjourned at 6:34 PM.
